

*EARLY SCHOOL
LEAVING
IN UKRAINE*



- ▣ Pupils in Ukraine leave school when they are 16-17 years old.
- ▣ It's different in each region
- ▣ They start school when they are 6-7 years old
- ▣ Studying is an 11 years old period

- ▣ After 9th form pupils can leave the school and start to work
- ▣ This is one of the reasons, why pupils leave earlier the school in Ukraine, than in other countries.



- ▣ Pupils don't need higher education, they can start studying at the university after 9th form
- ▣ After 9th form, they can apply jobs like waitress, cook, hairdresser, automechanic, agricultural worker, welder, etc.

- ▣ To some pupils, working abroad is the only way to earn money
- ▣ This is one of the reasons, why they are going to Poland (1,5-2 million), Czech Republic (1 million), Hungary (0,5 million), America, Germany (1 million), Austria, Spain, etc. (statistically)



- ▣ But they can choose to stay in Ukraine and make a living in they homeland
- ▣ In Ukraine and mostly in the Transcarpathian region it is not surprising that pupils often do unofficial work



- ▣ In Ukraine, education is centralised and they have more material than in other countries
- ▣ Education is deeply concerned to the ukrainian situation and pupils have to study everything about Ukraine more than about other countries
- ▣ The ukrainian education is different from the other countries' way of teaching

- ▣ The Transcarpathian and the Lviv region are outstanding, because there you can find different schools, where the teaching is in different languages, not just ukrainian (e.g. hungarian, romanian, russian, polish, slovakien).
